

MINUTES OF THE PLEASANT TOWNSHIP BOARD OF TRUSTEES
REGULAR MEETING
FEBRUARY 19, 2026
5:30 PM

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The meeting was called to order at 5:30 PM by Trustee Miller with all Trustees present.

Minutes from the February 5 meeting were approved as submitted.

Fiscal Officer Report – James Snyder

Bank reconciliation for January was submitted.

Receipts of \$6,414.09 and payments of \$95,646.97 since the last meeting. All bills submitted were approved for payment.

Ohio Division of Liquor control issued a notice of a proposed Ownership Change for Lancaster Greenhouse C-1 and C-2 liquor permits. A response requesting or not requesting a hearing is required by March 13.

26-010 Mr. Fowler moved to not request a hearing on the matter of Lancaster Greenhouse C-1 and C-2 permits; seconded by Ms. Moellendick. Voting: Fowler - yes; Miller - yest; Moellendick - yes Motion approved.

SLFRF closeout report is due by April 30. Trustee Miller will file the report and the Fiscal Officer provided a copy of the signed Award Terms and Conditions if they have not already been uploaded.

Public Comment:

Ms. Sydney Strite informed Trustees that United Way is offering free income tax preparation subject to income and return complexity limitations.

Sgt. Williams said he and the IT department are working on getting statistics for 2025.

Zoning Report – Zoning Inspector Joseph Boyer

Zoning Inspector Boyer reported 1 permit for \$350.00 issued since the last meeting.

Road Department Report – Road Superintendent Jason Boyer

Weight Limit signs have been posted.

Supposed to receive at least one load of the salt ordered the end of January with the balance in 2-3 weeks.

Trimming trees, patching potholes and doing equipment maintenance.

Purchased 3 blade cutting edges from Parts Resources at \$278 each versus \$399 from Ace.

They have an old stone box that has not been used for years. Trustees agreed to list it on GovDeals starting at \$50 considering potential scrap value and the time/gas required to take it to disposal.

Fire Department Report – Chief Michael Hutton

New ice maker was received and installed but was inoperative. Warranty repair found a bad wire terminal. Unit is repaired and operational. A problem with the Community Room ice machine was discovered to be caused by someone changing the cube size setting that caused the machine to stop filling the mold.

2 personnel are attending SCBA Tech level 1 school.

5-inch hose has been received.

Notified that an EMS Training Grant of \$1,125.00 was awarded.

Colton Hartman has resigned his 6th day spot and will be staying part-time starting March 7th.

26-011 Mr. Miller moved to accept the resignation of Colton Hartman from his 6-day position effective March 7, but will remain a part-time firefighter; seconded by Mr. Fowler. Voting: Fowler - yes; Miller - yes; Moellendick - yes. Motion passed.

Online training for Vector Solation for Fire and HR is up and running.

Light in bay area has been repaired.

Chief offered to add the Road workers to the HR training in the Fire/HR training application.

Work is continuing on the Blood Pilot program with Pleasant and Violet being the two departments in the county still being considered.

Chief asked if he could post Ohio Township Association information about effects of real estate tax repeal. There are 3 items – An OTA flyer emphasizing essential services Townships provide every day, the text of the Governor’s address to the OTA Winter Conference and an Office of Management and Budget memo to the Governor outlining consequences of abolishing local property taxes.

Trustees gave verbal approval.

Jason Miller: Summarized his recent conversation with the State EMA regarding last July’s storm damage. Stringtown funding should be received soon, Rainbow needs some pictures, Ginder would be approved for a 10-foot section and work may be done as a joint Township/County project, Cattail funding would be limited to the headwall.

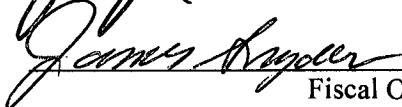
Rayna Moellendick: Discussed work on Elder Road and meetings with the County Engineer.
